



Luc Bodiguel is Research Professor at Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique, France (laboratoire « Droit et changement social). He works mainly on agricultural and food law and policy, focusing on the impact of Law on Agricultural and Food System, on the accordance of these rules with individual and collective practice and on agriculture and food Law and Policies in the face of environmental and climatic challenges. His research and publications have focused on local food governance, agroecology, water resource governance, multifunctionality of agriculture, Natura 2000 and ecological corridors, pesticides issues, climate change challenges, agricultural interbranch organisation, low-carbon strategy. He published more than 100 articles or book chapters. He teaches Agricultural Law, Environmental Law, Contract Law and Sustainable Law in Masters Degrees. He has several phd students and is member of several Organisation among which the Legal Research Chair in Food Diversity and Security (Laval university Canada), the European Council For Rural Law and the World Union Of Agricultural Law.
