



Michael Cardwell is Emeritus Professor of Agricultural Law at the University of Leeds. His research has focused on agricultural support regimes and agriculture in world trade, with publications including: *The European Model of Agriculture* (OUP, 2004); *The Regulation of Genetically Modified Organisms: Comparative Approaches* (OUP, 2010) (co-edited with Luc Bodiguel); and *Research Handbook on EU Agriculture Law* (Edward Elgar, 2015) (co-edited with Joe McMahon). Since 2013 he has been Assistant Delegate General of the CEDR. He was invited to provide oral and written evidence to Parliament on the implications of Brexit for United Kingdom agriculture; and he has been involved in research projects which explore the new framework being developed to provide financial assistance to English farmers.
