



Prof. Dr. iur. Roland Norer studied at the School of Law at the University of Vienna, where he obtained his Master of Law (Mag. iur.) in 1994 and his Doctor of Law (Dr. iur.) in 2000 with a dissertation on legal philosophy and legal theory. In 2005 he completed his post-doctoral lecture qualification at the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences, Vienna with a habilitation on “The evolution of agricultural law. Legal problems posed by rural law”. He worked for the Austrian Federal Ministry of Agriculture, Environment and Water Management and joined the School of Law at the University of Lucerne as a Extraordinarius in public and rural law in 2007, since 2015 as Ordinarius. 2021 Awarded honorary doctorate (Dr. h.c.) at the University of Miskolc (Hungary). He is General delegate of the C.E.D.R. and president of the Austrian Association of Agricultural and Environmental Law. Moreover he publishes the CEDR-Journal. He published numerous papers especially on agricultural, environmental and administrative law.
